**SAFD Engine Company Station #3
including a Charleston County Medic Unit
to be located at 1814 Old Parsonage Road**

Following our last update of November, 2022, Charleston County Council approved almost \$2 million to partner in the construction of a new fire station to be built by St. Andrews Public Service District (SAPSD). The new station, which will replace the current St. Andrews Fire Department (SAFD) Station #3 located just across from the new site on Ashley River Road, will be located at 1814 Old Parsonage Road on the site formerly known as Church Creek Plaza.

The partnership will soon be confirmed by way of an Intergovernmental Agreement between the two municipalities.

Trident Construction continues to work diligently with the team to create a facility that would best serve the needs of the residents of West Ashley. The design for SAFD Station #3 was amended to include space and living quarters for the crew and medic unit for CCEMS. Coast Architect is in the final phase of building design and HLA Engineering will complete the site plan for the station, stormwater retention pond and passive park. Once through the permitting phase of the project, the initial land disturbance will begin with removal of the concrete.

There are no definite plans at this time for future use of the existing SAFD Station #3.
